Conferment Ceremony of Decoration on Mr. Heinz Kress, Japanese *Inro* Researcher and Collector, on 7 October at the Residence of the Ambassador of Japan

The Ambassador of Japan, H.E. Mr. Takashi Murata, is going to confer the decoration on Mr. Heinz Kress, Japanese *Inro* researcher and collector, at the Conferment Ceremony at his official residence on Monday, 7 October as part of the 2019 Spring Conferment of Decoration on Foreign Nationals decided by the Government of Japan on 21 May. Mr. Kress will be bestowed the decoration "Order of Rising Sun, Silver Rays" on him in recognition of his outstanding contributions to promote Japanese culture overseas through the research of Japanese *Inro*.

Inro are light and multi-tiered containers especially for medicines formerly worn by men. Its fashion spread among the samurai, and they became increasingly popular during the Edo period (17th-19th Century).

Mr. Kress with his wife, **Mrs Else Kress**, encountered *inro* in 1964. They moved to Finland on business in 1970's and started to collect and research *inro* actively. After selling their business in 1990, the Kresses have been able to dedicate themselves fully to their passion towards *inro*. In 2010, they collaborated with Museum Centre **Vapriikki** in Tampere, to hold a huge *inro* exhibition.
