Letter of Acknowledgement

I hereby acknowledge that I have been given the explanation and understand the followings regarding the refusal letter that I have submitted.

- ☐ The Refusal Letter of Passport Application that I submitted would become invalid depending on the situation of my custody right of the child.
- ☐ I will withdraw the Refusal Letter in writing without delay in case that the custody conflict is solved and I come to consent to the passport application for my child.
- ☐ If there is a change in my address and telephone numbers, I will notify it to the Japanese Embassy, Consulate General or the prefectural passport office in Japan without delay. Failing to do so, I may not be informed when the passport application is done for my child, and the passport for my child would be issued.
- ☐ If I withdraw the Refusal Letter and intend to apply the passport for my child, the Japanese Embassy /Consulate General / the prefectural passport office in Japan will also make sure of the consent of another custody right holder.
- ☐ If I do not hold the custody right of the child under Japanese law, regardless of the refusal letter I submitted, there is a possibility that the Japanese passport for the child would eventually be issued according to Japanese law.
- ☐ The valid Japanese passport currently issued to the child cannot be revoked.
