- Climate change threatens the humanity. Its resolution is our responsibility for the next generations.
- Japan will continue to exert leadership toward an early adoption of one new comprehensive legal document establishing a fair and effective international framework in which all major economies participate, based on the Copenhagen Accord(Copenhagen, December 2009).
- (1) Japan has set an ambitious target of emission reduction(25% reduction by 2020 compared to the 1990 level).
- (2) Japan is supporting developing countries(total assistance of approximately 15 billion dollars up to 2012). Assistance totaling 5.32 billion dollars there of has already been implemented by the end of April.
- (3) Japan will host Ministerial Meeting on Forest Conservation Cooperation and Climate Change(REDD+)(on the margin of the CBD-COP 10. October 26th in Nagoya, Aichi is proposed).
